Psalm 105, 106. Last 2 Psalms of Book IV

105: *How God Treated Israel*

106: *How Israel Treated God*

7 sections

(introduction, followed by 6 ways that God showed His unconditional love for Israel)

7 = completion, perfection

1. 105:1-7. Introduction
2. 8-11. God Honored His Promise to Abraham
3. 12-15. God Established Abraham's Children
4. 16-22. God Protected His People from Themselves and from Famine
5. 23-36. God Delivered His People from Bondage
6. 37-41. God Provided for His People in the Wilderness
7. 42-45. God Fulfilled His Promise of Blessing

The **PURPOSE** for **remembering God's Faithful Care.** 105:1-7

- "Give Thanks" (v 1)
- "Make know among the nations what he has done" (v.1)
- "Sing" (v 2)
- "Glory in his holy name" (exult - our recognition to HIM)
- "Remember the wonders" (v 5)

Our Questions Today:

- Can God Care for Me during this time of trouble?
- Will Jesus return as He promised? (2 Peter 3:3-4) *"First of all, you must understand that in the last days scoffers will come, scoffing and following their own evil desires. They will say, 'Where is this 'coming' he promised? Ever since our fathers died, everything goes on as it has since the beginning of creation.'"*
- Can God Save my lost family and friends?
- Can God Keep those who are His?

- We find the answers to these questions as we look to how He FAITHFULLY CARED for us in the PAST.
  - ★ In the BIBLE
    - He parted the sea
    - He brought down city walls
    - He held the sun in it's place
    - He healed the lepers
    - He raised Martha's brother
    - He rolled the Stone Away
  
  - ★ In My LIFE
    - He softened a heart of stone
    - He opened my eyes to see hidden truths in His word
    - He melted my unforgiving spirit
    - He enabled me to be a blessing to others
    - He saved my children
    - He saved my marriage
    - He answered my prayer
    - He enlarged my faith
  
  - He NEVER CHANGES.

*(Psalm 90:2) "Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God."*

*(Psalm 102:25-27) "In the beginning you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. Like clothing you will change them and they will be discarded. But you **remain the same**, (hua) and your years will never end."*

*(Psalm 103:17) "But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord's love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children's children—"*
