 - 2. Subject is YHWH!

 - 1. 112:2. The blessings on the one who fears the Lord
- E. Psalm 111 = The **DOCTRINAL** reason for the fear of the Lord
- F. Psalm 112 = the **PRACTICAL** reasons for the fear of the Lord

- 1. Both Psalms 10 verses
- 2. v 1-8, 2 lines each (16 lines)
- 3. v. 9-10, 3 lines each (6 lines)
- 4. The First word in EACH LINE form the HEBREW ALPHABET
- 5. Both Psalms - 3-4 words per line
- 6. 111
 - a. 16 lines w/ 3 words
 - b. 6 lines w/ 4 words
- 7. 112
 - a. 10 lines w/ 4 words
 - b. 12 lines w/ 3 words

 - 3. Provides redemption
