Question (15:1)

Answer (15:2-5a)

Assurance (15:5b)

- I. The Question. "Who may dwell in your sanctuary?"
 - A. Reference to intimacy with God.
 - B. The owner determines what conduct is acceptable for the guests.
- II. The Answer. 15:2-5a
 - A. General answer
 - 1. Blameless. No fault. "Complete, sincere or perfect"
 - 2. Righteous.

Integrity is more important than religious technique

- B. Specific answer.
 - 1. Speaks truth. (**Pos**)

- 2. No slander (neg)
- 3. No harm to neighbor (neg)
- 4. No slur, insult (neg)
 - a. Comments, lies, gossip, stereotypes
 - b. Does not lift self by insulting others
- 5. Despises a vile man (pos), honors those who fear the Lord. *Hates the things God hates*
 - a. Isa 5:20 Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter.
- 6. Keeps his oath even when it hurts (pos)
 - a. Truth and integrity more important than personal gain
- 7. Does not accept a bribe (neg)
- III. Assurance. Not be shaken.
