**WORSHIP and RESURRECTION**

Occasion: Bringing the ARK to JERUSALEM  
2 Samuel 6. David leaping before the Lord. Joy - Worship - Victory

- I. 24:1-6 Approaching God
  - A. God's Purposes "The earth is the Lord's"
    - 1. He has a purpose
    - 2. Everything will praise the Lord (Psalm 150:6 "let everything that has breath praise the Lord.")
  - B. God's Presence. "Who can ascend. . ."
    - 1. Clean hands (actions)
    - 2. Pure heart (attitude, motives)
    - 3. No idols (priorities)
  
- II. **24:7-10 Enjoying God**
  - A. "Lift up your heads". . . The inhabitants of the city welcome God's presence
  - B. "Who is the King of Glory?"
    - 1. The ARK - the glory of God
    - 2. MESSIAH -
  
  - C. IN MATTHEW
    - 1. Matt. **21:1-10** They welcome Jesus (human distinction)
    - 2. Matt. **25:31. When he returns, he will be KING.**
  
  - D. In ZECHARIAH
    - 1. Zech **9:9**
    - 2. Zech **14:9**
  
- III. Is Christ King in your life?
