 - B. When evil people afflict God's children. **Psalm 37:1-2**
 - 1. Suffering Christians (Sudan, China, Middle East)
 - 2. People gaining through lies and deception
 - 3. When God is mocked and ridiculed
 - C. Christians overcome by evil.
 - 1. Immature
 - 2. Temptations
 - 3. Those who fall away
- II. WHAT TO DO 37:3-9
 - A. Trust in the Lord. 34:3
 - B. Do good. 34:3
 - C. Dwell in the land. Don't lose your joy. Don't surrender! NKJV "Dwell in the land and feed on His faithfulness"
 - D. Delight yourself in the Lord. 34:4 Delight = "enjoy, be fond, i.e., take pleasure and enjoyment in an object, implying desirability of the object" (Swanson)
 - E. Commit. 37:5 "HE WILL DO IT"
 Why will He do it? It is HIS reputation at stake, not yours!
