Psalm 40 -

2 sections.

- 1-10 PRAISE for GOD's DELIVERANCE Looking BEHIND PAST victories
- 11-17 HOPE for continued DELIVERANCE Looking AROUND trials continue Need for continued mercy

Speaks both of DAVID and CHRIST Read 1-10 Hebrews 10:5-7

Christ is Seen throughout the Psalm

- Patience. V. 1 *Christ is patient with us.*
 - He endured suffering (Heb 12:2 "Let us set our eyes on Jesus, the author. . .who for the joy . . ."
 - "when he suffered he made no threats" 1 Peter 2:23
- He lifted me out of the slimy pit. Jesus was **lifted up.**
 - slimy pit no footing.
 - a picture of death
 - Eph 4:9 "He that ascended is he that descended. . ."
 - Phil 2:7 "he made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness."
 - God lifted Jesus. Did not allow his servant to see corruption. Acts 13:34-38
 - (Philippians 2:9, NIV) "Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,"
 - (Acts 2:23-24, NIV) "This man was handed over to you by God's set purpose and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross. But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him."
 - (Acts 2:36, NIV) ""Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.""
 - A NEW SONG. Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the Law.
 - We now hear his voice. John 10:27-30
