#### II. We're Desensitized and Don't Know It

#### III. We've Deserted and Don't Care

- A. No one is shooting at us because we are "OUT OF UNIFORM"
- B. Civil war battles. The guy carrying the flag ALWAYS GETS SHOT. The next soldier picked up the flag, knowing how dangerous it was.
- C. **TODAY.** NO ONE WANTS TO PICK UP THE FLAG. There is **NO HONOR.**
- D. We've let the colors fall.
