Finding Yourself in the Psalms Psalm 74 A Psalm for Life's Devastating Circumstances

OVERWHELMED with anguish.

The TIME: Babylonian capture of Jerusalem. 586 BC

- 30 month siege! Jeremiah 39:1-4
- Psalm 74:4-11

I. QUESTION: Is This Judgment or Trial?

- A. For JUDAH: JUDGMENT. Eze 22:1-12
- B. For JOB: Trial.
 - 1. Job 1:8
 - 2. 7 sons, 3 daughters
 - 3. sheep, camels, oxen, donkeys
 - 4. "greatest man among all the peoples of the east" (Job 1:3)
 - 5. PLUS physical suffering

C. Personal illus - the attack on 9/11

- 1. Had been studying Islam
- 2. Knowledgable of Biblical phophesy
- 3. GOD's JUDGMENT has begun!

II. **RESPONSE:**

- A. Remember God's PLACE. Psalm 74:12
 - 1. God is SOVEREIGN (74:12)
 - 2. God is SAVIOR (74:13)
 - 3. God is still on the throne
 - 4. Asaph did not doubt God's place.
 - 5. "In all of this Job did not sin" **Job 1:22; 2:10**
 - 6. God still has an eternal plan
 - 7. NOTHING can interfere with His plan!
- B. Remember God's POWER. Psalm 74:13-15
 - 1. The LORD delivered Israel through the SEA (power over NATURE)
 - 2. The LORD delivered Israel from EGYPT (Leviathon) (*power over NATIONS*)
 - 3. The LORD provided Israel with WATER in the desert (*power over* **NEED**)
 - 4. The LORD has the POWER to deliver YOU! Remember what He has

done in the past.

- C. Remember God's PLAN in the world. Psalm 74:16-17
 - 1. God is not TROUBLED by anything!
 - 2. Psalm 139:12 "even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you."
- D. Remember God's PROMISES. Psalm 74:18-21
 - 1. Kim: "I haven't had to repeat one promise!"
 - 2. **Psalm 77:10-12**
- E. Remember God's attention to your PRAYER. Psalm 74:22-23
