"The Bible speaks of God's anger more than 100x" (Ray Pritchard, "Stealth Attack" 66). VENGEANCE - WRATH

(Isaiah 61:8) ""For I, the Lord, love justice; I hate robbery and iniquity. In my faithfulness I will reward them and make an everlasting covenant with them."

(Zechariah 8:17) "do not plot evil against your neighbor, and do not love to swear falsely. I hate all this," declares the Lord."

(Malachi 2:16) ""I hate divorce," says the Lord God of Israel, "and I hate a man's covering himself with violence as well as with his garment," says the Lord Almighty. So guard yourself in your spirit, and do not break faith."

(Proverbs 6:16-19) "There are six things the Lord hates, seven that are detestable to him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, a false witness who utters life, and one who spreads strife among brothers."

We minimize God's GRACE to the degree that we deny His VENGEANCE LET'S BE CLEAR - It is GOD who avenges.

ON EARTH - He has chosen HUMAN GOVERNMENT to carry out justice **Rom 13:1-4**

We must apply Psalm 94 on a spiritual level
