Almost seems to be **two Psalms**

**I. WORSHIP. 95:1-7a**

- A. Worship God for His SOVEREIGNTY. 95:1-5
  - 1. Invitation to worship- “Come”
  - 2. Object of worship - “LORD”
  - 3. Act of worship - “thanksgiving” “music and song”
  - 4. Reason for worship - “FOR”
    - a. The great God
    - b. The King above all gods
    - c. Depths of the earth
    - d. Montains
    - e. Seas
  
- B. Worship God for His CARE. 95:6-7b
  - 1. Invitation to worship- “Come”
  - 2. Object of worship - “LORD”
  - 3. Act of worship -
    - a. “bow down in worship” (prostrate)
    - b. kneel
  - 4. Reason for worship - “FOR”
    - a. He is our Elohim
    - b. We are his the people of his pasture

**II. WARNING. 95:7b-11**

- A. An example to learn from. 95:7a-9
  - 1. The wilderness generation
  - 2. Coincides with Hebrews 3-4
  
- B. A Punishment to fear. 95:10
  - 1. “Falling short of all that God has for you.”
  - 2. **Hebrews 4:1-11**
  
- C. A Situation to Avoid. 95:11
  - 1. Christianity without rest.

3. HOW? Hebrews 4:12-13
4. The dangers of hardening your heart after receiving God's blessings
  - a. No REST (wandering around the wilderness of life)
  - b. No REJOICING (over the fruit God would bring) - no JOY
  - c. No REWARD
  - d. No ASSURANCE. 1 John 2:3-6. "*we know that we have come to know him, . . .*"
