Algonquin 2019-is not just a camping trip. We will paddle through one of the best rated canoe routes in the WORLD. What to Expect:

There are three different trips we take as a ministry.

Algonquin Extreme- is a physically demanding trip. We will cover around, 40 miles of trails and lakes. Each day will consist of 5-8 hours of travel. Team members will learn navigation and camping techniques. Men need to be in good physical shape.

Teen Adventure - is less demanding. You will enjoy all the beauty of Algonquin, just at a slower pace. Expect travel to be 3-5 hours each day covering less than 20 miles overall.
